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a. Recommendation to City Council for Alternate Position to Planning Commission.

The Planning Commission received two applications for the Alternate Planning Commissioner position. Jones stated the city could start receiving applications for Cannabis Licenses and if that happens, they need to have the fee schedule approved with a Public Hearing by the City Council. The fees need to be in line with what is allowable per MN State Statue. Jones stated the State could start accepting applications as soon as June 2025.
